Under BC Cyclo-Cross Regulations

INTER AREA REGULATIONS

The composition of each team shall be declared to the Commissaire and/or the Chief Judge no later than 60 minutes before the advertised start of the race. No changes to the composition of the teams shall be made after the declaration. Medal presentation for the first three teams in the Youth race will take place at the BC presentation truck at 12:30 pm, and for the other categories at around 3.45 pm.

All prize money will be forwarded to regional secretaries by cheque in the week following the event.

All team members must wear Area or Region colours. If an Area/Region has secondary colours, or insufficient jerseys to kit out their full team, they should ensure that all members of the same team wear the same colours. Any departure from this procedure shall be at the discretion of the Chief Commissaire.

Eligibility: The regulations require all riders to compete for the BC Region in which they reside. In exceptional circumstances this regulation may be relaxed where a rider who resides close to a regional border wishes to ride for the adjacent region, provided that both regions agree. In the case of dispute, the residential qualification shall apply.

Substitute Riders: The regulations permit only those riders listed in the programme to compete. However, at the discretion of the Commissaire, substitute riders may be permitted to replace riders listed in the programme who are absent. This will ONLY be permitted if the absence of a listed rider means that a team has insufficient riders to qualify for team points. The substitute rider must meet the eligibility qualifications to compete for the Area/Region.

DIRECTIONS

From the South:

Leave the M1 at J13 and take the A421; follow the A421 over 1 roundabout; at the 2nd roundabout the road is called Standing Way (H8); continue along A421/Standing Way; turn right onto Watling Street (V4). After approx 600m entrance to MK Bowl is on the right.

From the North:

Leave the M1 at J14 and turn right on to the A509; proceed to the first roundabout and take the 2nd exit onto the A4146 Childs Way (H6); proceed on H6 over 9 more roundabouts until the junction of Watling Street (V4); turn left and proceed along V4 to the next roundabout where take the 2nd exit still on V4 after approx 500m turn left into the entrance of National Bowl.

PREVIOUS WINNERS
