## **INTER AREA REGULATIONS**

The composition of each team shall be declared to the Commissaire and/or the Chief Judge no later than 60 minutes before the advertised start of the race. No changes to the composition of the teams shall be made after the declaration. Medal presentation for the first three teams in the Youth race will take place at the BC presentation truck at 12:30 pm, and for the other categories at around 3.45 pm.

All prize money will be forwarded to regional secretaries by cheque in the week following the event.

All team members must wear Area or Region colours. If an Area/Region has secondary colours, or insufficient jerseys to kit out their full team, they should ensure that all members of the same team wear the same colours. Any departure from this procedure shall be at the discretion of the Chief Commissaire.

**Eligibility:** The regulations require all riders to compete for the BC Region in which they reside. In exceptional circumstances this regulation may be relaxed where a rider who resides close to a regional border wishes to ride for the adjacent region, provided that both regions agree. In the case of dispute, the residential qualification shall apply.

**Substitute Riders:** The regulations permit only those riders listed in the programme to compete. However, at the discretion of the Commissaire, substitute riders may be permitted to replace riders listed in the programme who are absent. This will **ONLY** be permitted if the absence of a listed rider means that a team has insufficient riders to qualify for team points. The substitute rider must meet the eligibility qualifications to compete for the Area/Region.

## **DIRECTIONS AND COMPETITORS CAR PARKING**

There are 2 designated car parks for competitors. The main car park is at Walkers Crisps head office, Bursom Road, off Leycroft Road. The post code is LE4 1BS. The car park will be signed from Leycroft Road.

The course will be clearly signposted from here and is around 400m walk to the start / finish area.

Please note that Walkers Crisps have made the event possible by kindly providing the use of their staff car park. **PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE RUBBISH AND / OR MUD IN THE CAR PARK** when you leave. Thank you.

The second car park is at the library that is situated close to the Leisure Centre. This will be signposted on entry to the shopping centre. Space is limited (70 spaces) and competitors to the later races are advised to park at Walkers Crisps (as above).

We would like to thank Beaumont Leys library for the use of their car park; please do not leave litter etc on the floor when you depart.

- From A46 take A5360 Anstey Lane in the direction of Leicester
- Continue to turn Left (1st exit) at 1st traffic island into Bennion Road
- For main car park, continue past traffic island and turn right into Leycroft Road, then left into Bursom Road.
- For second car park turn right (3rd exit) at first traffic island into Beaumont Way; follow road around the shopping centre, pass under a bridge and take left turn into competitors parking. This will be signed from the entrance to the shopping centre.

Please note that designated competitors parking is limited and therefore should be used **ONLY** by competitors.
